This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.3 dated 20.03.2019 registered under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act and Section 201 of the IPC at P.S. Vigilance Bureau, Jalandhar Range.

Custody certificate filed in Court by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh Dhaliwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Prison, Ludhiana is taken on record, wherein it has been certified that the the petitioner has undergone the custody of 01 month and 17 days.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that this is a case where no recovery has been made and the petitioner has been in custody for the last more than 1½ months.

Learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Kuljas Rai has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioners. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned C.J.M/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
