The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.501, dated 3.11.2017, registered under Sections 364, 34, 302 of the IPC, at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that all the witnesses have turned hostile and the petitioner has now been in custody for one year and about five months.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has been in custody for 1 year 4 months and 24 days. Learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar, has accepted the factual assertion made by counsel for the petitioner.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the

petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
