Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that he is apprehensive that the Appellate Authority i.e. Collector, Pathankot will not consider and decide his application, which has been submitted by him on 02.04.2019 (Annexure P-7), wherein, he has taken an objection that the initial application, which has been preferred by respondent No.2, is barred by the provisions of Order 11 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

This apprehension of the petitioner appears to be misplaced as the appeal is still pending and it is expected that the Appellate Authority will, while deciding the appeal, not only decide the appeal but also the application of the petitioner as well.
