This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 04.03.2017 registered under Sections 279, 336, 379, 506 and Sections 379-B IPC (added later on) and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 11.04.2019 by Kuldeep Kumar – Dsm, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Gurgaon is taken on record, wherein it has been certified that the petitioner has undergone the custody of 20 days.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the complainant party have turned hostile.

Learned Assistant Advocate General has accepted this fact.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny parity to the petitioner. Consequently, I grant regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
