Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.130 dated 22.12.2018 under Section 21 of the N.D.P.S. Act (Section 29 N.D.P.S. Act added lateron), registered at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation. As per learned State counsel, the petitioner is not involved in any other case under N.D.P.S. Act.

In view of the above, the order dated 04.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
