Learned counsel for the petitioner has confined his prayer for expeditious investigation in FIR No.5 dated 25.01.2018 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, Karnal. He states that the FIR having been registered on 25.01.2018, investigation in the case has yet not been completed.

The record reveals that there is a matrimonial dispute between the parties. Even respondent No.5 has filed a divorce petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act before the Family Court at Hisar (though it has been transferred to Karnal), which is pending.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case and noticing the fact that the FIR was registered on 25.01.2018 and it being a matrimonial dispute, the investigation in the case is not complete, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Karnal, to expedite the investigation and to complete the same preferably within six months from today.
