Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the official respondents Nos.1 to 6 to register an FIR against respondent Nos.7 to 10 on the basis of inquiry report, submitted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, on the complaint of petitioner for tampering the record and committing the forgery with the official record of Registrar, Death and Births.

In response to the notice of motion, issued by this Court, a detailed reply by way of affidavit of Ranjit Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Perusal of the preliminary submissions of the affidavit reveal that complaint, made by the petitioner, was duly enquired by the police officers at different levels including the Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Batala and ultimately, it has been found that the

Birth Certificates of Dalwinder Singh s/o Hardev Singh, Surjan Singh s/o Hardev Singh and Akwinder Kaur d/o Hardev Singh are found to be correct being correctional entries in the Office of Additional District Registrar, Births and Deaths, Gurdaspur.

In view of above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
