ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J.(ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 01.03.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 341, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Khanna City-2, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is the case of version and cross version and the petitioners were empty handed. The injury, for which offence under Section 307 IPC is attracted, is attributed to the co-accused Raghbir as he is alleged to have hit the injured with a brickbat.

This Court, by the order dated 03.05.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parmod

Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 03.05.2019 granting ad interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
