It comes out that one Sham Lal filed CRM-M-10907-2011 through Shiv Kumar, Special Attorney, under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing FIR No. 140 dated 14.5.2000, under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar. Said petition was dismissed by learned Single Bench of this Court on 8.1.2014 with observations that previously, wrong affidavit was filed by Shiv Kumar that no other similar petition was filed, whereas earlier petition was also filed. Therefore, this Court, vide order dated 8.1.2014, directed initiation of criminal proceedings under Section 340 Cr.P.C.

The learned counsel for respondent-contemner states that respondent is sixth class pass. He does not understand the technicalities of matter. Therefore, inadvertent error has crept in and respondent signed affidavit, given by counsel, without understanding same. He is ready to pay fine.

In these circumstances, respondent is directed to pay fine of Rs. 25,000/-, to be deposited before Legal Services Committee of this Court, within two weeks. Criminal proceedings initiated against respondent under Sections 340 Cr.P.C. are accordingly disposed of.
