This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful
disobeyance of order dated 6.12.2018 passed in CWP No. 24220 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Petition is hereby disposed of with the direction that in case petitioner sends a fresh copy of the legal notice/representation to the concerned authority alongwith a copy of this order by registered/speed post, the authority shall pass a speaking order at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks of receipt thereof. If any amount is found due to the petitioner, payment of same be released after sanction from the Finance Department, if required."

Mr. Aman Sharma, Advocate has filed reply today in Court, same is taken on record. Copy of the reply given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the order passed annexed with reply, an amount of ₹15,31,484/- due to be paid to the petitioner for which it has been stated that the funds have been asked from the State Government.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the matter would be perused by them and needful regarding payment would be done within three months from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in case any grievance survives the petitioner be given liberty to avail remedy as available in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made above, no cause of action survives.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

The rule issued against respondents is hereby discharged.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved of order, he shall be at liberty to take remedy as available in accordance with law.
