Petitioner Nidhi Saxena has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 23.06.2017, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the parties have already effected a compromise.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 08.04.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by

sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the compromise between the parties; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 08.04.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
