Prayer in this petition is for issuance a directions to the respondents to re-investigate FIR No.151 dated 05.10.2013, u/s 306, 120-B IPC and 7/12 Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, P.S. Dehlon, District Ludhiana from some independent agency (Criminal Branch).

Reply by way of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana Central Bureau of Investigation on behalf of respondent No. 3 has been filed by learned State counsel today in Court and is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

As per the reply, the police has submitted a cancellation report before the Illaqua Magistrate and thereafter, on a compliant given by the petitioner, the matter was again reinvestigated and again a cancellation report was submitted.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.6 has further submitted that in fact on two occasions a similar exercise has been done by the trial Court/Illaqia Magistrate for reinvestigation and on both the occasions, the police has submitted a cancellation report.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for filing a protest petition/complaint, if so advised.
