The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.112 dated 6.8.2014 registered at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Kailash Chander, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Nawanshahar has been filed by learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record.

Vide order dated 8.4.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Manga, Surinder Kaur and Gurmeet Lal and also of complainant Amarjit Kumar have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.112 dated 6.8.2014 registered at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
