GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to official respondents especially respondent No.2, not to harass the petitioner and other members of his family at the instance of private respondents and also for issuance of notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case there is any complaint against the petitioner.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh to look into the matter and in case the petitioner or other members

of his family are required to be associated with any inquiry or investigation or some information is to be elicited from them, then a written advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 be served upon them.

3. A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
4. It is however clarified that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to extend any kind of protection, in case there are allegations that the petitioner or other members of his family have committed any cognizable offence.
