This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer for issuance of directions to the official respondents for registration of FIR against respondent No.5 under the provisions of Indian Penal Code or any other law for threatening the petitioner and his staff.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for the alleged incident, which took place on 31.10.2017, a departmental inquiry was conducted but no action has been taken against respondent No.5 for his prosecution by registering a case.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing

the complaint, this Court finds that broadly the allegations are of misbehaviour and use of abusive language by respondent No.5, who allegedly extended threat also to the petitioner and his staff. The said act does not make out a cognizable offence and therefore this Court is not inclined to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is dismissed.

However, it shall be open for the petitioner to avail alternative remedy as per law.
