The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 15.01.2019, vide which, a direction was issued to decide the representation of the petitioners, at the earliest.

The said order was an ex-parte order to the extent that the respondents/State were not given an opportunity to file their reply.

Thereafter, learned counsel for the petitioners vide his forwarding letter dated 25.01.2019, has sent copy of order dated 15.01.2019 to the concerned authority. However, there is nothing on record to show that the respondents have ever been given either the representation or the writ petition.

In these circumstances, the respondents cannot be held guilty of contempt at this stage. Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to sent the order afresh alongwith copy of representation within two weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order, which shall be decided by the respondents within one month from the receipt of said representation. In case, the respondents still do not decide the representation, the petitioners are at liberty to file the fresh contempt petition.
