Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.0092 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Adarsh Nagar, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.3 today in the Court, is taken on record.

The case of the petitioners is that petitioner No.1-Pardeep has solemnized marriage with petitioner No.2-Komal and they are staying together as husband and wife. The marriage was solemnized between them against the wishes of respondent No.3-Bijender, who is father of petitioner No.2-Komal.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3, on instructions from his client who is present in the Court, submits that respondent No.3-Bijender, who is father of petitioner No.2-Komal, has no objection in case the present FIR is quashed as the petitioners are happily staying together as husband and wife.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Rajender Kumar and while referring to the reply submitted by an affidavit of Sh. Jaiveer Rathee, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ballabgarh, Faridabad filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2-State, submits that in the aforesaid FIR, the police has investigated the matter and prepared the cancellation report.

In view of the fact that the police has investigated the matter and prepared the cancellation report and the petitioners are staying happily as husband and wife, coupled with the fact that respondent No.3-complainant-Bijender has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed, this Court finds that in case the proceedings will continue in the case, no useful purpose would be served, rather it will disturb the whole family.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0092 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Adarsh Nagar, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
