Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.5 dated 13.01.2019 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Bakshiwala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 13.01.2019. Even Sunita Rani, who is mother of Manpreet, has given an affidavit that she is ready to give statement regarding innocence of the accused. He further states the co-accused Lachhman Kumar, being juvenile, is already on bail by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the custody as well as the submission made on behalf of the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that Sunita Devi has submitted an affidavit regarding the innocence of the petitioner and he being in custody since 13.01.2019, the trial in the case will take sufficient long time, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
