Petitioner Vikarm has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.438 dated 21.06.2017, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat (Haryana), under Sections 120-B/323/34//341/379-B/506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 302/201/216 of the Indian Penal Code added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The FIR has been got registered by complainant Surinder @ Talli injured (deceased), who has been murdered in this case and in his statement, he has not named the present petitioner in any way that he was

present at the spot or he has given any injury and the injuries have not been caused at his instance. The co-accused has nominated the present petitioner.

The petitioner has been in custody since 31.01.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, it is made clear that any observation made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
