The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.312 dated 08.12.2018 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC (Sections 325 and 307 IPC added later) at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

The operative part of the order dated 08.04.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is aged about 65 years and as per the allegations in the FIR, the injury on the head of the complainant Jasbir son of Krishan is attributed to Surinder, son of the petitioner, who has already surrendered before the trial Court. It is further submitted that the case of the petitioner is distinguishable from his son i.e. the co-accused Manoj @ Vinod, whose anticipatory bail i.e. CRM-M No.14063 of 2019 was dismissed as withdrawn on 28.03.2019. It is further submitted that the recovery has already been effected and after the arrest of the co-accused Surinder, a compromise has been effected, in which the complainant

Jasbir son of Krishan has given an affidavit.

Notice of motion for 11.04.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 08.04.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Krishan Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 08.04.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
