Report dated 10.01.2019 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate Jagraon has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners, namely, Gurpreet Kaur, Parambir Singh @ Paramveer Singh Dhaliwal, Gurpreet Singh @ Happy and Hardeep Singh @ Kali and respondents, namely, Sanjeev Kumar and Monika Rani @ Monkia Kakkar, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have vouched for the settlement that has been arrived at between them and prayed that the matter be quashed on the basis of compromise.

Heard.

In the light of joint statement made by the parties and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 90 dated 19.03.2018 under Sections 452, 354, 323, 379 and 427 IPC registered at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
