GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 96 dated 6.6.2016 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar (Rural) and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Mr. Harjot Singh Mann, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

3. Vide order dated 22.08.2017 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
4. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Mithu Kumar have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.
5. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 96 dated 6.6.2016 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar (Rural) and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
