The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing/setting aside or modifying the conditions imposed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide order dated 13.02.2019, whereby while granting regular bail to the petitioner he has been directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.75,000/- each with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate on any conditions, he/she likes to impose in case FIR No.25 dated 03.04.2018, registered under Sections 363/366-A IPC and Sections 5 and 6 of the Protection of children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (in short 'the Act'), at Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner and the prosecutrix have solemnized marriage with each other and both of them are residing together. However, the learned trial court has granted the bail to the petitioner, subject to the conditions that the petitioner

shall furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs.75,000/- each with one surety.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an indigent person and is unable to procure the security of the aforesaid amount.

Heard. Keeping in view the circumstances of the case, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate.

The instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.

However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same as early as possible preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
