By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.93 dated 08.06.2018 under Sections 306 & 34-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda.

Vide order dated 27.07.2018, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

On instructions from HC Gurwinder Singh, learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 27.07.2018 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made

absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
