Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.0060 dated 25.02.2019 under Sections 323, 354-A, 354-B, 354-D, 34, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are in custody since 01.03.2019. The allegation against the petitioners is that when the victim has gone out to bring wood, petitioner No.2-Sandeep @ Soni caught hold of her, torn the clothes and gave beatings to her, whereas petitioner No.1-Deepak followed and abused the victim five days before the matter was reported to the police. He further states that the matter has been compromised between the parties for which the complainant has submitted

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, does not dispute the custody. However, she states that challan in the case has already been presented and now the case is fixed for 19.04.2019 before the trial Court for framing of charge.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are in custody since 01.03.2019 and the complainant has submitted an affidavit dated 19.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) and even if the trial will be conducted, it will take a sufficient long time, this Court finds that the petitioners deserve to be admitted on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of their bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
