Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the trial Court at appropriate stage including his plea to the effect that the complainant's daughter had accompanied the petitioner out of her free will and had married the petitioner and that they are living together as husband and wife.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. The trial Court is, however, directed to expedite the conclusion of trial and to make efforts to conclude the same within the shortest possible time, preferably, within a period of 6 months from today while keeping in view the fact that the parties have solemnized the marriage.
