During the course of hearing, Anita, who happens to be the wife of Rajat Gosain, accused in this case has made statement accompanied by her affidavit and which is duly conceded to at bar by the accused that they have sorted out their matrimonial dispute and has started living together to which the State has no objection. The wife has specifically stated that she has no objection if interim bail granted to the petitioner be made absolute. Since the parties are husband and wife and have a small child out of this wedlock and in the fitness of things and for their future betterment and the fact that the offences for which the petitioner has been hauled up are not of serious nature and no useful purpose shall be served by detaining the accused behind the bars, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated

23.08.2017 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
