ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 159, dated 6.9.2018, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.2, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he threw a brick bat which hit on the head of the injured Pargat Singh @ Gora Gill. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 5 months since his arrest on 30.10.2018 and the matter has now been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P-3. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Custody certificate of the petitioner filed in Court today is taken on record which shows that the petitioner is in custody for over 5 months. Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Gurcharan Singh, states that the investigation has been completed but charges are yet to be framed.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 5 months and the matter has been compromised, I deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
