The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

The alleged marriage was performed on 29.01.2019, whereas this petition has been filed after a period of three months of the marriage. The representation dated 03.4.2019 (Annexure P-5) attached with the petition allegedly addressed to the Superintendent of Police Jhajjar, reveals that the applicants are major, who have solemnized the marriage without any pressure from any side and with their sweet will. At the same time, the

apprehension of threat is also mentioned without revealing any specific particulars about the same. The petition is also silent about the source and mode of alleged threat.

Resultantly, as the contents of the petition do not inspire confidence, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is hereby dismissed.
