GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 for protection of life, liberty and property at he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondent No.4.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Panchkula to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps

warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. It is further directed that in case, there is any genuine apprehension of threat to life, liberty and property of the petitioner, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Panchkula so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
