1. The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.248 dated 8.12.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 478 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Sections Tigaon, Distrcit Faridabad.
2. Today learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that both the parties have in fact compromised the matter and had resolved their dispute and have filed a petition for quashing of FIR bearing CRM-M-24180-2019, in which notice of motion has been issued.
3. In view of the aforesaid position, wherein the parties have resolved their dispute amongst themselves which is arising out of some agreement for purchase of property, I do not find that it to be a case of custodial interrogation. Accordingly the petition is accepted and

the interim directions issued vide dated 5.4.2019 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
