Pleadings on record indicate that pursuant to a complaint made by the Dr.Gazala Singh, an FIR No.165 was registered against the petitioner dated 11.9.2016, under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

It is the submission made by counsel for the petitioner that basis of registration of the FIR is a false and concocted medico legal report.

Petitioner seeks a mandamus to direct the State Government, Secretary, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab to conduct a fresh inquiry as regards the medico legal report in question.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that after completion of investigation, the

final investigation report has already been submitted by the Investigating Agency and charges already stand framed.

Trial having commenced, this Court would refrain from interfering in the matter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.

Suffice it to observe that it would be open for the petitioner to raise all pleas, that may be available to him, towards his defence, in accordance with law.
