Prayer in the petition is to quash FIR on the basis of compromise/settlement.

Allegations are that the petitioner impersonated as Sh. Tirath Singh Thakur, Chief Justice and tried to pressurize Chancellor of a Education Institution to admit a student.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that other co-accused have been acquitted after trial. Hence, he submits that the FIR should be quashed.

In the FIR, main allegations are against the petitioner. Role of the petitioner is quite distinct from other accused. Allegations made are serious in nature. Hence, no ground to quash FIR on the basis of compromise is made out.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
