This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.32 dated 17.2.2017, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, on the basis of compromise allegedly entered into between the parties.

On 28.3.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for recording their statements in respect of the compromise. Pursuant to the said order, a report from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Moga, has been received, wherein it is intimated that the complainant

Gurdev Singh failed to appear for recording his statement.

In view of the above, the solitary ground raised in this petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has vanished.

The petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, it shall be open for the parties to move an appropriate application for compounding of offence before the trial Court, in case the compromise is still in existence.
