This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 16.8.2016 passed in CWP No. 16437 of 2016.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the present petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into and examine the claim of the petitioners in the light of a legal notice dated 2.2.2016 (Annexure P-8) i.e. stated to have already been served.

A final decision be taken thereupon by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed of."

Learned State counsel on instructions from Gaurav Sharma, Assistant, o/o DEE Haryana states that the decision has been taken on the legal notice dated 2.2.2016 of the petitioner. The claim has been accepted and payment of ₹24,988/- on account of arrear w.e.f. 21.9.2018 to 31.10.2010 and ₹11,611/- on account of interest has been paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that order of this Court has been complied with.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved of order passed by respondent, he shall be at liberty to avail remedy as available in accordance with law.
