This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 988 dated 10.11.2018, under Sections 333, 353, 186 of the IPC (Sections 307, 506, 34 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Ballabhgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, co-accused Kuldeep gave a spade blow on the forehead of the SPO Sandeep Kumar, who had gone to spot to calm down the dispute between the two rival groups.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per the allegations, the injury invoking Section 307 IPC is not attributed to the petitioner and he is ready to deposit a demand draft of Rs. 30,000/- favouring the complainant/SPO Sandeep Kumar, without any prejudice to his right to defence.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Pal, has

not disputed the factual position and submitted that challan has already been presented and the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned and on deposit of a demand draft of Rs. 30,000/- favouring SPO Sandeep Kumar, which shall be handed over by the trial Court to the official concerned.
