Prayer in the application is for condonation of 47 days' delay in filing the present petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

Delay of 47 days in filing the present petition is condoned.

MAIN CASE

Present revision petition has been filed under Section 401 of the Code of Criminal Procedure against the impugned order dated 26.11.2018, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda, whereby the petitioner has been directed to deposit 20% of the amount of compensation awarded by learned trial Court while suspending his sentence during the pendency of appeal in view of the provisions of Section 148 (2) of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 2018.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner states that instead of challenging the aforesaid impugned order, petitioner seeks 30 days more time for deposit 20% of the amount of compensation awarded by learned trial Court.

Prayer seems to be justified and accepted.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to deposit the 20% amount of compensation in terms of the impugned order within 30 days from today.

Till then, conditional bail granted to the petitioner by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda shall continue.
