Petitioner-Parminder Kaur @ Naano has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.251 dated 17.12.2018 under Sections 323, 307, 365, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana. The petitioner is in custody since her arrest on 22.12.2018.

As per the version of the prosecution in the FIR, which was recorded on the statement of Dalip Kumar, the victim was forcibly taken in a vehicle by accused, namely, Bhupinder Singh @ Rinku, Baljinder Kumar @ Kali and Arjun Kumar to the house of Sunil Kumar (husband of the petitioner) where his wife (petitioner) was also present. According to the allegations, the victim was given beatings, however, according to learned counsel for the petitioner, no injury was attributed to the petitioner.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, there is previous enmity between the parties and the motive mentioned in the FIR itself i.e. pendency of other criminal case and possibility of false implication cannot be ruled out.

On the other hand, learned State counsel assisted by ASI Kulwant Chand opposed the bail application. It is not disputed that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. It is also not disputed that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Considering the above background of the case and the fact that the petitioner is a lady and trial of the case is likely to consume more time, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner is not justified. Therefore, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to her furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, Ludhiana.

The petition is allowed.
