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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.**(Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail pursuant to his bail bonds/surety bonds having been cancelled on account of his absence before the trial Court as on 11.3.2019.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that absence of the petitioner before the trial Court as on 11.3.2019 was not intentional but was on account of the fact that initially the case was proceeding before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class but the Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class having found that offence under Section 450 IPC is also made out, committed the case to the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge and that it was on account of lack of clarity in the mind of the petitioner that he could not appear before the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, to whom the matter had been entrusted after commitment.

Pursuant to directions issued by this Court on 8.4.2019, the petitioner is stated to have appeared before the trial Court as is also evident

from a photocopy of order dated 30.5.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, which has been produced by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the aforestated position, where the absence of the petitioner is the first instance of default on his part and also that the petitioner has since appeared before the trial Court, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order 8.4.2019 are hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall, however, ensure his presence before the trial Court on each and every date.
