Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.07 dated 05.02.2019 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act 1985 at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

According to the prosecution, in the evening of 05.02.2019, petitioner was apprehended with 100 strips of Tramadol 100 mg, containing 10 tables each, 30 strips of Alprazolam 0.5 mg, containing 10 tablets each and 30 strips of Lorazepam 2 mg, containing 30 tablets each.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that FSL report has not yet been received. Therefore, it cannot be said at this stage that alleged recovery was a narcotic substance. Petitioner is in custody since 05.02.2019.

In view of above, but without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the case, the petitioner is granted interim bail subject to furnishing

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personal bonds and two sureties of ₹ 2.00 lakh each, to the satisfaction of Special Court concerned only till receipt of the FSL report.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
