Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to conduct independent inquiry regarding the involvement of Ravi Shankar son of the petitioner in FIR No.90 dated 27.12.2017 registered under Section 21, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Special Cell Delhi Police.

A perusal of the petition shows that before filing of this petition, the petitioner has given some representation on 18.6.2018.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division City, Hoshiarpur, has been filed in Court today wherein it is stated that no such representation was ever received by the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur. In this affidavit, details of as many as 20 FIRs pending/decided against the petitioner has been given out of which in 17 FIRs son of the petitioner stands convicted and in 3 FIRs, he is facing trial.

In view of the above, no further action is called.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
