Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to carry out fair and impartial investigation and take appropriate action against respondent Nos. 4 to 7 in FIR No.0174 dated 26.06.2018 (Annexure P1) registered under Sections 307, 452, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the incident relates to 26.06.2018 and till the filing of the present petition, no action was taken by the police.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the affidavit of DSP, Sub-Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, which is already on record, submits that during investigation, three suspected persons were exonerated and one person was arrested and he was granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh,

further submits that Sections 307 and 452 of the IPC stand deleted and the challan will be presented in due course.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move appropriate application/complaint before the trial Court for redressal of his grievances in accordance with law, if so advised.
