Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.47 dated 19.02.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Punhana, District Nuh.

The case has been registered on the complaint of Saddik Mohammad working in Forest Department, Delhi with the assertions that he had taken the land in Rectangle No.69 Killa No.3/2 (1-16) 2 kanals 16 marlas from Lala Ram son of Hukmi son of Ram Nath resident of Delhi in the year 1947 before partition of the country. The land was transferred in the name of complainant, Rasid, Wahid and Salekha etc. On 03.01.2006, Salekha sold out his land to Smt.Nirmla Kumari resident of Pinangwan. Accused Lala Ram son of Hukam Singh, Mumtaj, Rahul Nek Ram Sharma, Rati Ram, Bhagat Singh, Dal Chand, Ali dealer, Pratap Bahadur and some other persons fraudulently forged documents of sale and presented the same before the Sub Registrar, who sent the same to the concerned Sub-Registrar at Jewar for verification and found that the General Power of Attorney was fraudulently prepared by impersonating original Lala Ram.

The learned Additional Sessions Judge has found that since the documents are required to be recovered from the petitioner, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
