The petitioner along with his brother Hardial Singh is stated to have purchased a total area of 14 *kanals* and 3 *marlas* comprised different parcels of land in Village Boparai Kalan, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar. They are stated to have exchanged their land with one Saroop Singh vide agreement dated 28.03.2010 of equal measurement. The mutation is stated to have been sanctioned on 09.04.2010.

It transpires that a portion of the exchanged land belonged to the *shamlat patti* and was thus not in the ownership of said Saroop Singh resulting into cancellation of mutation vide impugned order dated 22.09.2016 (**Annexure P-2**). Hence the present writ petition after a delay of almost two and half years.

At the time of hearing, realizing that the writ jurisdiction is not the proper forum to seek the remedy, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition to enable his

client to seek his alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
