Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing complaint No.12698 of 2010, dated 11.06.2010, titled as "***Registrar of Companies vs. Max India Ltd.***" pending in the Court of CJM, Chandigarh (P-1) along with summoning order dated 21.08.2010 (P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners are ready to pay the compounding fee calculated by the respondent i.e. ₹50,000/-.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioners to deposit ₹50,000/- with the respondent within

a week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case above composition fee for violation of provisions of Section 372-A(3) of the Companies Act, 1956, is not deposited within stipulated period, the instant petition shall stand automatically dismissed.
