By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.597 dated 19.11.2017, registered under Sections 365, 364, 302, 201, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Pehowa.

Vide order dated 30.07.2018, notice of motion was issued to the State. Meanwhile, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

On instructions from police official, learned State counsel submitted that the petitioner is accused only for the offence under Section 25 of the Arms Act and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 30.07.2018 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when

called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
