Through this petition, the petitioner has sought a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to enquire the matter relating to case FIR No.205 dated 29.06.2017 registered under Sections 307, 34 IPC as well as under Section 302 IPC at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh, through any independent agency like CBI, Crime Branch or by constituting special investigating team.

The previous order dated 26.4.2018 shows that the police had already filed challan in the case and even prosecution evidence had been going on. Accordingly, the proceedings of the trial may even be over by now. However, there is no representation on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner and even the counsel for the respondent is not aware about this. It appears that the petitioner is no more interested to pursue this case. Hence, this Court finds no reason to adjourn this matter any further.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
