AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.6 dated 08.06.2017 registered under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC read with Sections 13(1)(D) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Phase -1, Mohali.

On 25.08.2017 the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 07.10.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.6 dated 08.06.2017, registered under Sections 420, 520, 120-B read with Sections 13(1)(D) and 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act at Police

Station Vigilance Bureau, District Mohali, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from AIG Ashish Kapoor has stated that the challan has been prepared and the petitioner is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 25.08.2017 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
