The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 30029 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the claim as set out by the petitioner in his representations, direct the respondents to consider and decide his representation (Annexure P-8) by passing a speaking order thereon, as expeditiously as possible.

Disposed of.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Wazeer Singh Goyat, (IAS),

Director General, Development and Panchayats Department has been filed

in court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per direction of this Court, order has been passed and the present petition has been rendered infructuous. However, in case there is any grievance survives against the order passed by the respondents, liberty be granted to the petitioner to avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.
