The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide FIR No.18, dated 14.1.2013, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar, under Sections 279 and 427 IPC.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any ground for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition, as such, is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 2 weeks from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 3 days from filing of such application while also considering the contentions of the petitioner that he has been seriously ill. The trial Court shall pass a speaking order while considering the medical record /record produced by the petitioner.
